

Open Call ARTIST IN RESIDENCE MUNICH + URRA 2021

Residency for Artists Based in Buenos Aires, Argentina, from 2 July to 28 September 2021*. Application Deadline: 30 April 2021

We are accepting applications from artists based in Buenos Aires (City and Province) for a fully funded three-months residency at the **Villa Waldberta**, Germany, as part of the program ARTIST IN RESIDENCE MUNICH (AIR-M), located near the Starnberg Lake, in the outskirts of Munich, Germany. <u>www.air-m.de</u>

This exchange programme proposes an alliance between the Department of Art and Culture of the City of Munich (Kulturreferat der Landeshauptstadt München) and the organization URRA in Buenos Aires (Fundación VERIA), that will host an artist from Munich in 2021/2022, and it is supported by Goethe-Institut Buenos Aires, Instituto Cervantes Munich and the Government of the City of Buenos Aires.

The Residency Comprises:

- An individual apartment and common working spaces in AIR-M Villa Waldberta from 2 July to 28 September 2021.
- A return flight from Buenos Aires/Argentina to Munich/Germany.
- A monthly stipend of 1.200 Euros.
- A ticket for public transport in Munich (MVV Ticket).
- The participation in the program of the residency AIR-M Villa Waldberta and the possibility of having a presentation or exhibition at the Instituto Cervantes in Munich.
- General assistance.

<u>Eligibility</u>

- Argentine artists living and working in Buenos Aires, in the City of Buenos Aires and/or in the Province of Buenos Aires.

- There is no age limit, but this residency is not thought for students or artists that are just starting their professional career.

- We expect artists to carry out a solid project related to the residency's context and program.

- Good level of English and/or German.

Jury of selection

Via this Open Call a jury will select an Argentine visual artist living and working in Buenos Aires (City and Province), to participate in an art residency in AIR-M Villa Waldberta (Germany), between July and September 2021.

About the jury

The jury will be composed by representatives of the two residency programs and the entities supporting this exchange programme. If needed, external professionals will be appointed.
The jury can call applicants for an interview. It also has the right to declare the call as vacant for unexpected reasons, and to invite an artist in a direct way. The jury's decision will be final.

The winner artist will be announced before Saturday 15 May 2021.

Applicants commitments and obligations

- To participate in the AIR-M Villa Waldberta residency the appointed months.

- To participate on the activities of the project according to its schedule

- To give back a written report of the experience to AIR-M and to URRA.

- To name both entities of this partnership (AIR-M and URRA) when mentioning the programme, and when possible the other entities involved: Goethe-Institut Buenos Aires,

Instituto Cervantes, Gobierno de la Ciudad Autónoma de Buenos Aires.

- To participate in an audiovisual presentation of the experience when returning to Argentina.

- To be responsible of her/his travel and medical insurance during the journey and stay in Germany.

- To have a valid passport to be able to travel in time.

- It is important to mention that this residency is to be undertaken individually (not for partners or families).

- The participation in the Open Call implies the acceptance of the above conditions offered by the project.

1. A cover sheet with the following information:

Name and surname, date of birth, place of birth, Id and passport number, years of residence in Buenos Aires and current address, e-mail, telephone, website if there is one, plus confirmation that you will be available from 2 July to the 28 of September 2021.

2. Level of English and/or German (none, basic, good, very good, excellent).

3. A CV/Resume (one page).

4. An artist's statement describing your practice and areas of interest (under 200 words).

5. A work plan that includes an initial idea of a project you would like to carry out during the residency, including objectives and or motivations (under 500 words).6. A maximum of 15 images of your work or projects representing your work, with captions and a short description if necessary.
